All that portion of the William M. Murphy D. L. C. in Sections 27 and 34 in Township 3 North, Range 8 East, W. M., lying South of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company right of way, together with shore-lands of the second class situated in front of and adjacent to or abutting upon that part of the William M. Murphy D. L. C. included in Section 34, Township 3 North, Range 8 East, W.
