This Indenture Witnesseth, That I, Jeanne Meneilly, a widow, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars, in lawful money of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by Zed Porter and Alma Porter, husband and wife, residing at Underwood, Wash. parties of the second part, have GRANTED, BARGAINED, and SOLD, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, the following described real property, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamanh State of Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 218 feet east of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of section twenty-two, then east 198 feet on the north line of section 22, then south 220 feet, parallel to the east line of section 22, then west 198 feet, parallel to the north line of section 22, thence north 220 feet, parallel to the east line of sec. 22, to the point of beginning, and containing one acre, more or less, the same being in township three north of range 10, east of the Willamette Meridian.
