Easement Deed.

The Grantors Fred R. Frazer and Myrtle M. Frazer, husband and wife of Skamania County, Washington, for and in consideration of one (\$1.00) Dollars, in hand paid, CONVEY and WARRANT to Pacific Power and Light Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, an easement or right of way for an electric transmission and distributing line of one or more wires and all necessary or desirable appurtenances (including telephone and telegraph wires, towers, poles, props, guys and other supports and including the right to place all said lines in underground conduits) at or near the location and along the general course now located and staked out by the Grantee over, across and upon the following described premises, located in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-one (21), township three (3) North, Range ten (10) East, Willamette Meridian.

Together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the Grantors for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, stringing new wires, on maintaining and removing said lines and appurtenances, and exercising other rights hereby granted.

All rights hereunder shall cease when said lines have been abandoned.
