QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That JAMES BORIN and VERA M. BORIN, husband and wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by SKAMANIA COUNTY, a municipal corporation, party of the second part, do by these presents remise, release, convey and quit claim unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all interest of said parties of the first part in that certain forty foot right-of-way or road, running across the lands of the parties of the first part, situated in the Westerly portion of Skamania County, Washington, along the North Fork of the Washougal River, which passes through Sections 5, 6 and 7, Township 2 North, Range 5, East of the Willamette Meridian, and being twenty feet on either side of the center line, except on grades, cuts and fills, then in no event more than thirty feet on either side of the center line, which is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
