convey and warrant to the State of Washington, the following described real estate situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington:

Commencing at the center of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 8 East of the Willamette meridian; thence South 89° 55' East to the Easterly Right of Way line of Secondary State Highway No. 8-C, Wind River Bridge Vicinity, and the initial point of beginning; thence continuing South 89° 55' East 550 feet; thence turning right an angle of 90° 330 feet; thence North 89° 55' West to the Easterly right of way line of said highway; thence Northwesterly following along the Easterly right of way line of said highway to the point of beginning.

The lands being herein conveyed contain an area of 3.00 acres, more or less, the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval Nov. 27, 1956, and the center line of which is shown of record in Book "A", Highway Plats, page 2, records of said county, revised Dec. 11, 1956.

It is understood and agreed that the delivery of this deed is hereby tendered and that the terms and obligations hereof shall not become binding upon the State of Washington unless and until accepted and approved hereon in writing for the State of Washington, Department of Highways, by the Chief Right of Way Agent.

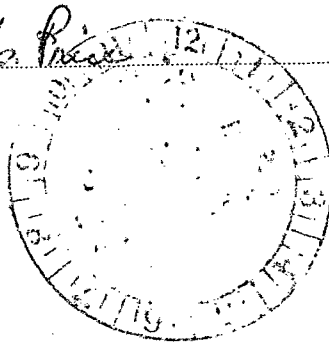

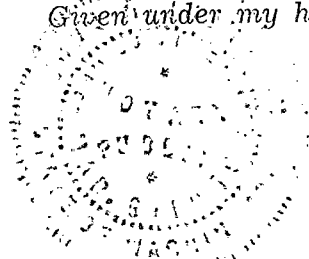
