CERTIFICATE OF GROUND WATER RIGHT

(Issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 263, Laws of Washington for 1945, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology thereunder.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That WINNIFRED AALVIK

of North Bonneville, Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public ground waters of the State of Washington from a well located within that part of the G.W. Johnson D.L.C. # 38 within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20, Twp. 2 N., R. 7 E. W.M., for the purpose(s) of domestic supply under and specifically subject to provisions contained in Ground Water Permit No. 10072 issued by the Department of Ecology and that said right to the use of said ground waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of record in Volume 15 at page 7364-A; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 9, 1970; that the quantity of ground water under the right hereby confirmed for the aforesaid purposes, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 9 gallons per minute; 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year, for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such ground water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east line of the G.W. Johnson D.L.C. No. 38 and the northerly right of way line of U. S. Highway 830 (PSH No. 8) within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20, T. 2 N., R. 7 E. W.M.; thence north 52.5 feet to the southerly right of way line of the Bonneville Power Administration power line; thence north 62°02' west along said right of way line 616.4 feet to the southerly bank of Greenleaf Slough; thence south 47°55' west 72.9 feet; thence south 48°37' east 368.4 feet to the said right of way line of U. S. Highway 830; thence north 64°16' east 191 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to use of water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.382, 90.03.390 and 90.44.020.

This certificate of ground water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
