have/has granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do/does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns a perpetual and assignable easement and right of way for the purposes hereinafter stated in, upon, under, over, and across that certain parcel of land situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Subject only to rights outstanding in third parties and reservations, as shown on Schedule "B" attached hereto and made part hereof.

The easement and right of way hereby conveyed are for the following purposes, namely:

The perpetual right, power, privilege and easement permanently to overflow, flood and submerge the land described in Schedule "A" and to maintain mosquito control in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Bonneville Lock and Dym project as authorized by the Act of Congress approved 20 August 1957, and the continuing right to clear and remove any brush, debris and natural obstructions which, in the opinion of the representative of the United States in charge of the Project, may be detrimental to the project, together with all right, title and interest in and to the timber, structures and improvements situate on the land; provided that no structures for human habitation shall be constructed or maintained on the land, that no other structures shall be constructed or maintained on the land except as may be approved in writing by the representative of the United States in charge of the project, and that no excavation shall be conducted and no landfill placed on the land without such approval as to the location and method of excavation and/or placement of landfill; the above estate is taken subject to existing eastments for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads and pipelines; reserving, however, to the landowners, their heirs and assigns, all such rights and privileges as may be used and enjoyed without interfering with the use of the project for the purposes authorized by Congress or abridging the rights and easement hereby acquired; provided further that any use of the land shall be subject to Federal and state laws with respect to pollution.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement and right of way unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns forever.

We, the grantors above named, covenant with the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA that we are lawfully seized and possessed of the land aforesaid; that the easement and right of way hereinabove described is free and clear of all encumbrances, except as above noted, and that we will forever warrant and defend the title hereof and quiet possession thereof against the lawful claims of all persons whomsever.

The true and actual consideration for this transfer is \$3,000.00.

The foregoing recital of consideration is true as I verily believe.
