

A satisfactory site evaluation was obtained for lot #1 of the above captioned short plat. Lot #2 has friable soil which should have good permeability; however, some mottling was observed which is an indication of a possible water table problem. For this reason a "winter evaluation" will be done on lot #2. The "winter evaluation" would indicate whether a modified system such as a "cap system" would be necessary.

I anticipate that lot #2 will also prove satisfactory and therefore recommend that the short plat be approved.
