depose and say:

That this affidavit is for the purpose of supplying information for record pertaining to that certain Community Property Agreement executed by FRANK EARL WITTENBERG and JOAN GEORGIA WITTENBERG, husband and wife, dated the 25th day of November, 1967, and recorded on November 27, 1967, under Skamania County Auditor's File No. 69374, in Book 58 of Deeds, at Page 204-5, records of Skamania County, Washington; and also, to the estate of Frank Earl Wittenberg, deceased, one of the parties to said agreement; and

It is intended that the statements set forth herein shall be considered representations of fact which may be relied upon by all persons dealing with the following described real property, to-wit:

REAL PROPERTY (Skamania County, Washington):

Parcel No. 1 - An undivided one-third interest in a tract of land consisting of 49.42 acres, more or less, in Section 29, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M., more particularly described in deed recorded at page 507 of Book 49 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County, Washington; EXCEPT that portion thereof platted as Columbia Heights AND EXCEPT parcels conveyed therefrom.

Parcel No. 2 - An undivided one-third interest in the following Lots; Lots 16, 18, 21, 23, 25, 28, 39, 40, 44, and 45 of Columbia Heights according to the official plat thereof on file and of record at page 136 of Book A of Plats, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

Parcel No. 3 - A tract of land consisting of 3.54 acres, more or less, in Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M., as more particularly described in deed recorded at page 20 of Book 34 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

FIRST: That Frank Earl Wittenberg died on July 21, 1979 in White Salmon, Klickitat County, Washington, leaving estate in Skamania County, State of Washington.



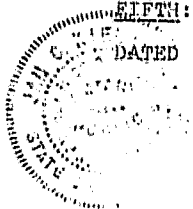
SECOND: That the parties of said agreement entered into no subsequent agreements which would have the effect of abrogating or nullifying the above-mentioned Community Property Agreement.
