Notice of location must be recorded within thirty days from the date of discovery at the office of the auditor of the county in which such discovery was made. Twenty Acres may be included in one placer claim and if located on surveyed land it must be according to legal subdivisions.

Provided however, that certain federal regulations may apply, in addition or in place of the above.

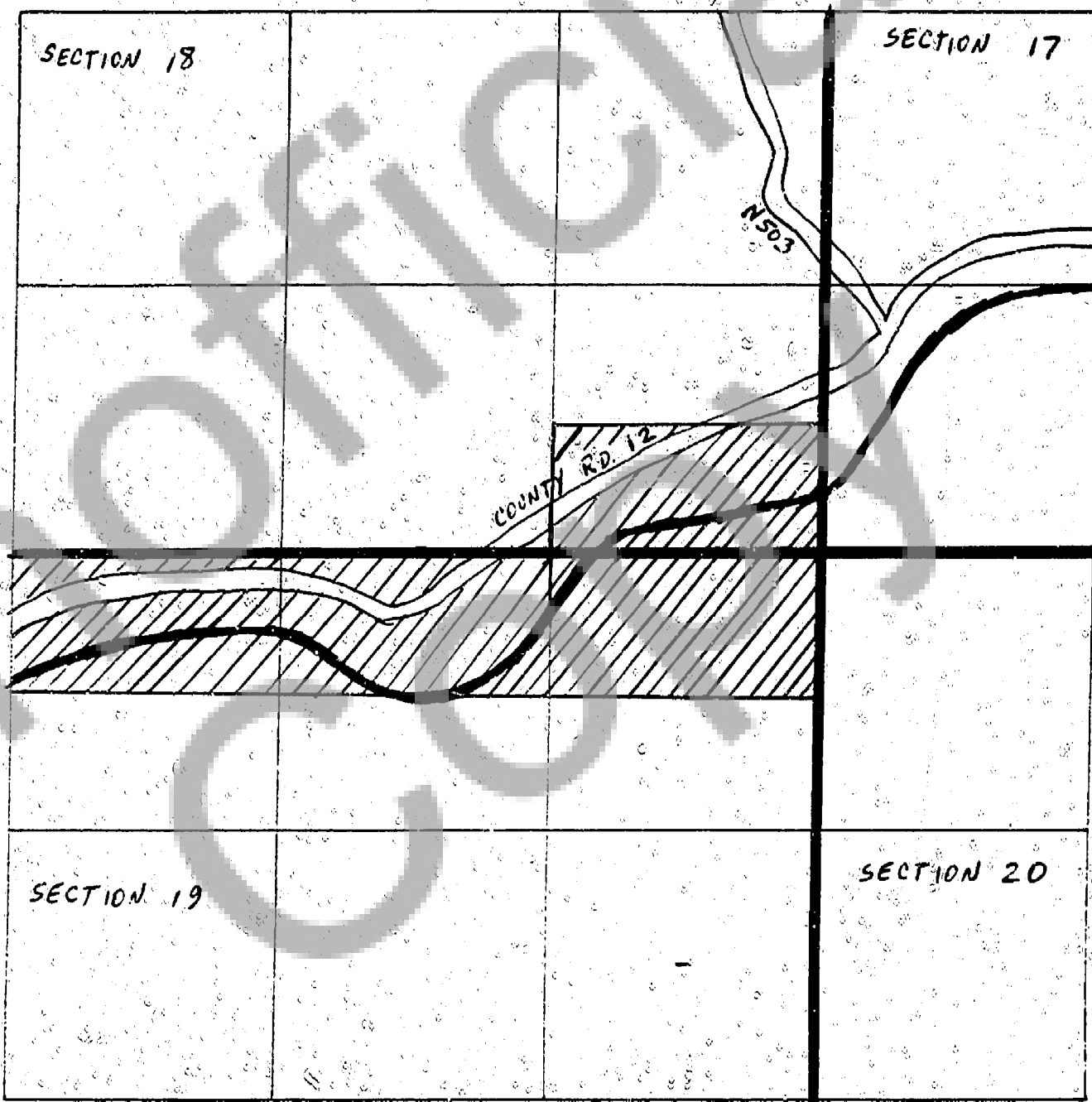

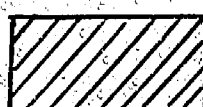
