

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District, has located and do ~~Es~~ hereby locate 1500 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the R.G.D. #1 lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence 600 feet in a NORTHWESTERLY direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 1500 feet in a NORTHEASTERLY direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 600 feet in a SOUTHERNLY direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 1500 feet in a SOUTHWESTERLY direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 600 feet in a NORTHEASTERLY direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 1500 feet in a SOUTHWESTERLY direction to said end post No. 2; hereby locating and intending to claim 1500 feet in a NORTHWESTERLY direction from discovery to the end line, and 1500 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the end line and 1500 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.
