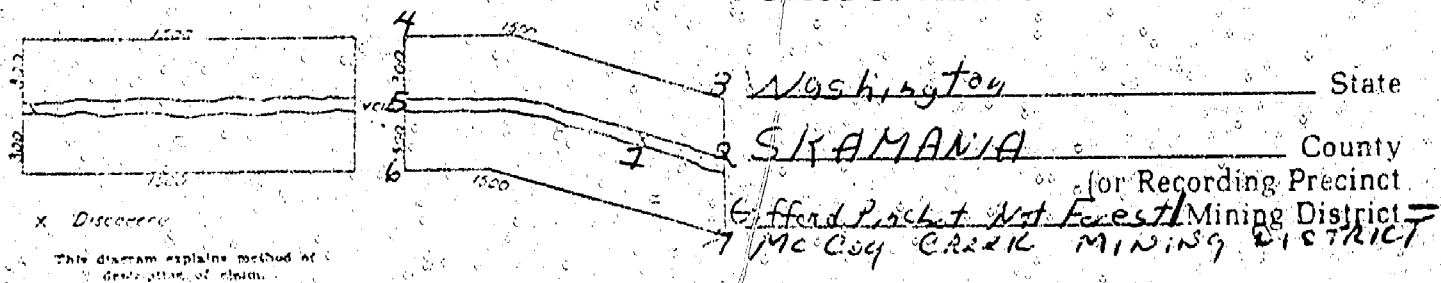

NOTICE OF MINING LOCATION



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned who is/are (has/are) declared _____ intention to become citizen _____ of the United States, have discovered and have located and claimed and do hereby locate 1500 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the FIRST STRIKE MINES Lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County (or Recording Precinct) and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence 100 feet in a S/W direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 300 feet in a S/E direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 1500 feet in a N/E direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 300 feet in a N/W direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 300 feet in a N/W direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 1500 feet in a S/W direction to said end post No. 2, hereby locating and intending to claim 1400 feet in a N/E direction from discovery to the N/E Center end line, and 100 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the S/W Center end line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, grades, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is further described by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, as follows:

Discovery Point is located on Eagle Creek,
approx. 40 ft. from East of Eagle Creek junction
with Forest Service Road # 111. Claim boundary's

to east end line. Adjoining claims are second
strike on the east and third strike to the west.

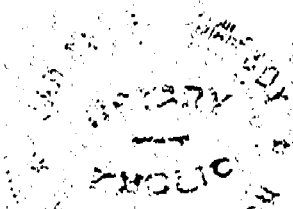
This notice is placed at Discovery on post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner, and the name of this lode and date of location, are placed on all posts.

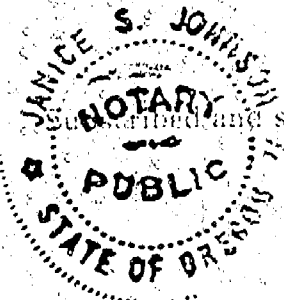

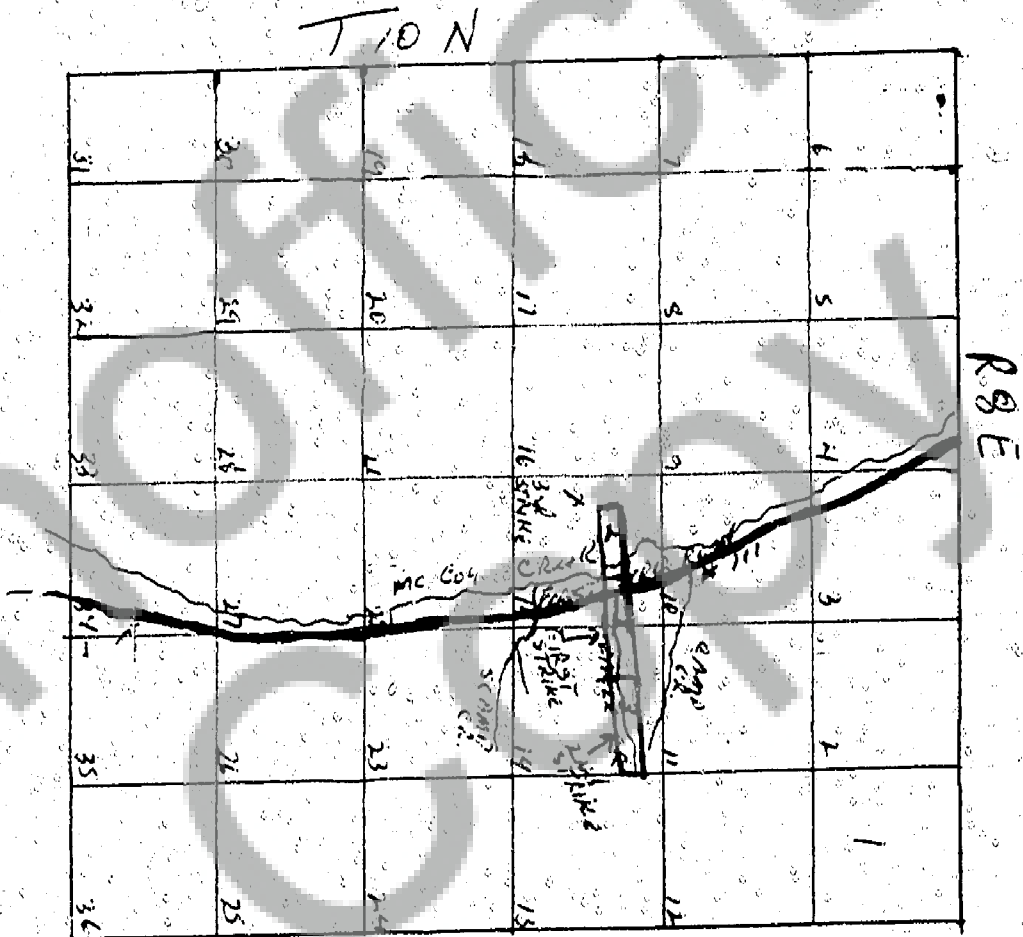
