The court further orders:

- 1) The equity of \$23,630.74 in the family residence located at .006 Eymann Cemetery Road, Carson, Washington 98610 is awarded 1/2 to Petitioner and 1/2 to Respondent. Said 1/2 belonging to Petitioner shall be paid forthwith or bear seven (7%) percent interest per annum until paid.
- 2) The equity of \$13,100.00 in the land more legally described as: The North 105 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 36, Township 4 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian. EXCEPT the North 205 feet thereof in Skamania County, State of Washington is awarded 1/2 to Petitioner and 1/2 to Respondent. Said 1/2 belonging to Petitioner shall be paid forthwith or bear seven (7%) percent interest per annum until paid.
- 3) Petitioner is awarded physical custody of CHRISTOPHER JOHN BERTLOVICH born October 9, 1971, and KATHY LYNN BERTLOVICH born January 20, 1974.
- 4) Respondent is to pay to Petitioner as and for child support \$150.00 per child per month for a total of \$300.00 per month due 1/2 on the 1st and 1/2 on the 15th of each month commencing September 1, 1981. Said child support is to be secured and paid by wage assignment.
