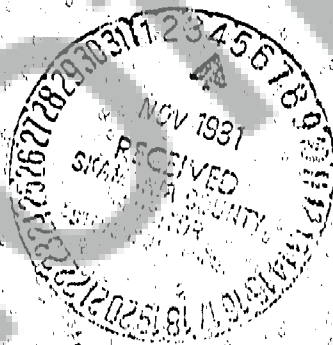

During the assessment year 1981 four (4) man days labor was performed on the claim. This consisted of excavating and removing the overburden to determine the Eastern extent of the quartz vein and of extracting material for analysis and assay. Extent of vein not found yet-- more to do in 1982. The labor was performed by Russell A. Niblock and Ted R. Martin and estimated at \$50.00 per man day indicates \$200.00 assessment work excluding indirect costs.

Analysis of material excavated so far does not indicate an economical operation however the U.S. Forest Service planned Boulder Creek timber sale and road in the area may "tip" the economy scales more favorably. In 1982 I plan to request a mineral examination by the Forest Service to help me decide whether to continue or "Throw in the towel".
