2. Description of Evidence Found:

1 1/2" Iron shaft 6" above ground.

Orig. 48" now 30" rotted Pine stump N27E, 39.6 ft. to face (record N22E, 60 lks.) no marks remaining.

Orig. 30" now 40" rotted Pine stump S16E, 21.6 ft. (record S30E, 30 lks.) no marks remaining.

3. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record. Surveyor's Field Book No. 2 Page No. 6 Date of work Oct. 1981

Set 2 1/2"x30" Gal. steel pipe with a 2 1/2" Brass cap. Buried steel shaft next to monument set. Marked:

Set guard post Southeast with sign 54-4 only.

Nailed 54-4 and BT signs to all BT's and painted band and blades red.

New Bearing Trees:

18" D-Pin S56W, 19.4 ft. scribed S26 upper blaze and a lower blaze scribed BT and with a 3/4" Brass disk stamped PLS 16337.

10" D-Pin S23W, 22.0 ft. scribed S35 upper blaze and a lower blaze scribed BT and with a 3/4" Brass disk stamped PLS 16337.
