1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration:
Tree originally marked by Deputy Jacob Richardson under Contract No. 459 in July/Aug. 1895.

2. Description of Evidence Found:
10 ft. tall snag partially rotted could have been 50 in. 572 ft. North of Southeast corner Section 10 and nearly on line between SE & NE corner Section 10.
For tie see Field Book One, that tie was to the approximate center of the snag.
The point referred to is 30' South on line to reflect where the Deputy measured to.

3. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record. Surveyor's Field Book No. 5 Page No. 15 Date of work 4/82

Set 2"x30" Aluminum pipes with a 2"x4" Aluminum cap N45E, 2.45 ft. and S45W, 2.65

Set guard post South with sign 54-4 and BM 102 decal.
Nailed 54-4 sign to tree and painted red.
