Orig. 36" now 44" D-Fir N/2E, 45.5 ft. (to face) scribing visible on partially healed blaze.

Orig. 18" now rotted D-Fir mound 1 ft. high S12E, 55.7 ft.

Orig. 15" now 26" Cedar S30W, 64.5 ft. (record 66 ft.) scribing visible on open face.

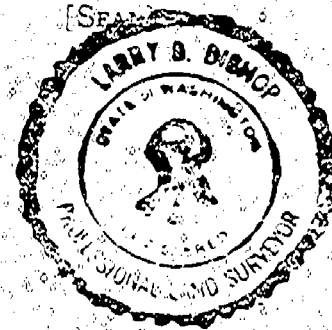
