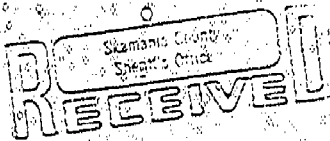
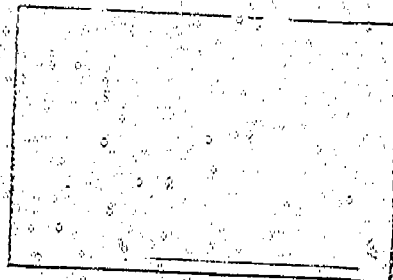

of Skamania County, Superior Court No. 6 9 9 9; and

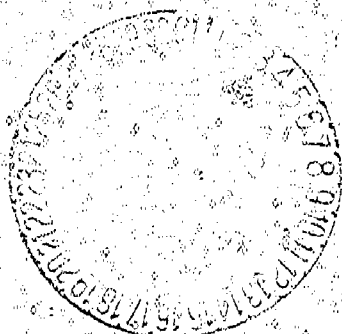
Whereas, the judgment is a foreclosure against each and
