- 22" white Fir stump broken off with visible scribe 54 1/2° W 7.26' the rest of the tree is lying S. of stump
- 28" white Fir N 41° W 15.18' with face partially grown over and axe marks in face (Also fd 54.3 signs with no marks on the OBTS)
