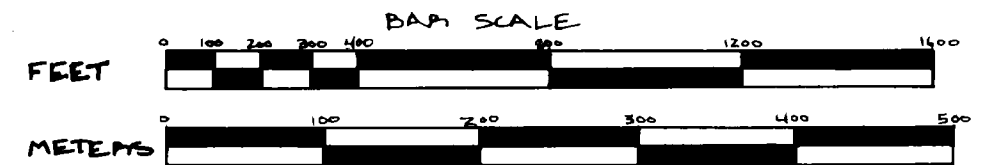


HISTORY OF SURVEYS

THIS SECTION WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED BY DEPUTY LEWIS D.W. SHELTON IN JULY, 1899, & OCT. THRU DEC., 1900, UNDER CONTRACT NO. 552. REMONUMENTATION BY FLOYD A. BROOKS, CADASTRAL SURVEYOR, IN OCT & NOV. 1961. THE BOUNDARY WAS RETRACED AND THE SECTION SUBDIVIDED BY PETTITJOHN ENGINEERING IN 1957.
