BM 24" Iron post with 3" Brass cap.
Orig. 22" now 30" D-Fir stump S7E-19 lks. blaze grown over.
Orig. 16" now 30" D-Fir S60W-19 lks. blaze grown over.
Brooks 9" now 12" Hemlock stump healed blaze N62E-36 lks..
