 13" Hemlock S23 $\frac{1}{4}$ E-35 lks.. 8" Hemlock S71W-48 lks..

 50" Cedar N47 $\frac{3}{4}$ W-38 lks..

 BIM 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron post with Brass cap.
 Orig. 30" now 52" Cedar N57 $\frac{3}{4}$ W-38 lks. (record N47 $\frac{3}{4}$ W) scribing visible on partially healed blaze.
 Orig. 10" now rotted 25" Wh. Fir stub 3 ft. high S63W-38 lks..
 Orig. 40" now 50" broken Cedar stub 5 ft. tall N74E-70 lks. (record N65 $\frac{1}{2}$ E-7 lks.) blaze burned away.
 Brooks 9" now 12" Cedar S60E-31 lks. healed blaze.
 Brooks 8" now 11" Hemlock S71W-48 lks. healed blaze.
