lying in the following places.

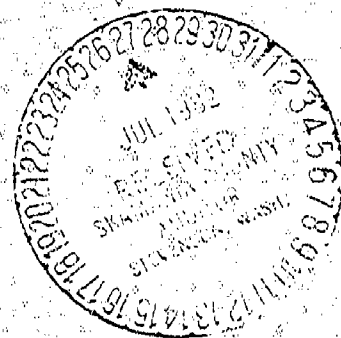

logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Burlington
Northern Railroad (B/N) whose agent is My Son's Logging, Inc.,
that B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., employed said Wayne Epperson to
perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following
terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the
said Wayne Epperson for such labor and assistance \$10,103.94; that
said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied
with on the part of said Wayne Epperson, who performed labor
upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of two months;
that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon
said logs between the 3rd day of June, 1982 and the 23rd day of
July, 1982 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that
the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$10,103.94;
that no part thereof has been paid except \$1,895.96, and there is
now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just
credits and offsets, the sum of \$8,207.94 in which he claims a

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lien upon said logs. The said Wayne Epperson also claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc. of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
