

AMENDED LIEN

State of Washington, claims a lien upon logs, being about 68 loads
in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County,

lying in the following places:

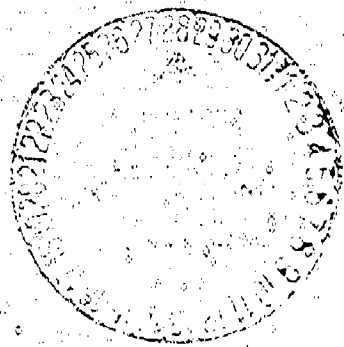
- A. RSG Forest Products, Kalama, Cowlitz County, Washington

- E. Rain Creek Sorting Yard, Chelatchie Prairie, Clark County, Washington

for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling
said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is
Burlington Northern Railroad (B/N) who's agent is My Son's Logging, Inc.,
that B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., employed said Jack Bartlett
to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the
following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the
said Jack Bartlett for such labor and assistance \$13,803.12; that
said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied
with on the part of said Jack Bartlett, who performed labor
upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of two
months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and
rendered upon said logs between the 28th day of May, 1982, and
the 23rd day of July, 1982; and the rendition of said service was
closed on the 23rd day of July, 1982, and thirty days have
not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's

demand for said service is \$13,803.12; that no part thereof has been paid except \$2,868.05; and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$10,935.07 in which he claims a lien upon all said logs. The said Jack Bartlett also claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.

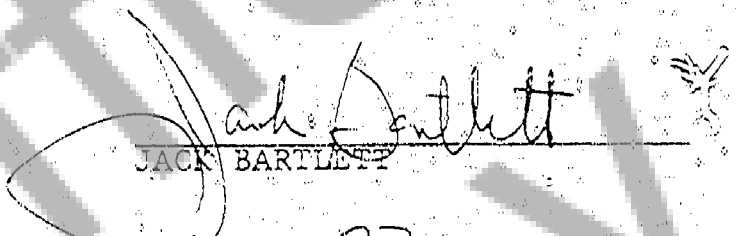
THIS LIEN corrects and supersedes that certain lien dated July 26, 1982.

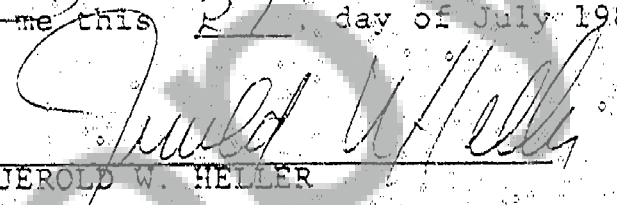

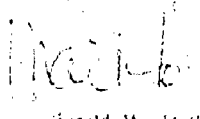
