said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is
Burlington Northern Railroad (B/N) whose agent is My Son's
Logging, Inc., that B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., employed
said Tony Luchau to perform such labor and render such
assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay
the said Tony Luchau for such labor and assistance \$13,678.30
that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully
complied with on the part of said Tony Luchau, who performed
labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period
of 11 weeks, that said labor and assistance were so performed
and rendered upon said logs between the 3rd day of May, 1982,
and the 19th day of July, 1982; and the rendition of said
service was closed on the 19th day of July, 1982, and thirty
days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of

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claimant's demand for said service is \$13,678.30; that no part thereof has been paid except \$6,706.00; and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$6,972.30 in which he claims a lien upon said logs. The said Tony Luchau also claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
