1, 1982 thru July 16, 1982, that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs including the time between the 1st day of July and the 16th day of July, 1982; and the rendering of said service was closed on the 16th day of July, 1982, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is Seven Hundred Eighty Seven and 50/100ths (\$787.50) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, the sum of Seven Hundred Eighty Seven and 50/100ths (\$787.50) Dollars less applicable Federal and State payroll deductions, for which amount he claims a lien upon said logs.

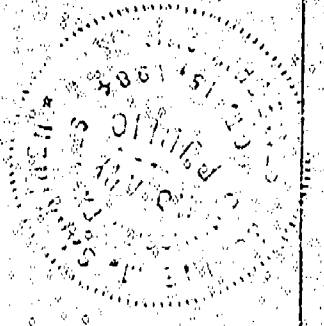
