SECOND AMENDED LIEN

ROY McCALL, CLAIMANT, VS BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD AND
MY SON'S LOGGING INC.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Roy McCall of Cowlitz County,
State of Washington, claims a lien upon logs, being about 74 loads
in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County,
State of Washington, are marked thus ^{BN} 26, and ^{BN} 28, and are now
lying in the following places:

- A. RSG Forest Products, Kalama, Cowlitz Co., Washington
approximately 30,000 feet.
- B. Wall Boom, Woodland, Cowlitz Co., Washington approximately
175,000 feet.
- C. Van Port Manufacturing, Boring, Clackamas Co., Oregon
approximately 20,000 feet.
- D. Pacific Lumber & Shipping, Longview, Cowlitz Co., Washington
approximately 135,000 feet.
- E. Rain Creek Sorting Yard, Chelatchie Prairie, Clark Co.,
Washington approximately 10,000 feet.

for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said
logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Burlington
Northern Railroad (B/N) whose agent is My Son's Logging, Inc.; that
B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., employed said Roy McCall to
perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following
terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the
said Roy McCall for such labor and assistance \$11,354.01; that
said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied
with on the part of said Roy McCall, who performed labor upon
and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of six weeks,
that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon
said logs between the 4th day of June, 1982, and the 16th day of
July, 1982, and the rendition of said service was closed on the
16th day of July, 1982, and thirty days have not elapsed since that
time, that the amount of claimant's demand for said service
is \$11,354.01; that no part thereof has been paid; and there is
now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just
credits and offsets, the sum of \$11,354.01 in which he claims a

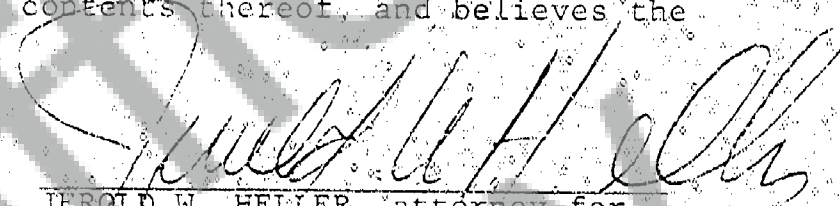
lien upon said logs. The said Roy McCall also claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
