

Notice of Location of Placer Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, who is a/are (or ha___ declared___ intention to become) citizen___ of the United States, ha___ on this 23 day of August, 1982 discovered at the place where this notice is posted a valuable placer deposit bearing GOLD AND PLATINUM and other valuable minerals, and do___ hereby locate and claim same as the MRK - 1 Placer Mining Claim.

This claim is situated in the GIFFERD PILCHET NATIONAL FOREST (COPPER CREEK) Mining District, Section 31 in Township 4 NORTH Range 5 EAST SEALAKE COUNTY, WASHINGTON

The point of discovery whereon this notice is posted is situated West bank of COPPER CREEK about 1500 feet upstream above COPPER CREEK BRIDGE marked as point of discovery

and from thence the boundaries of said claim are marked and described as follows:
Point (Corner) No. 1 located on left side of road 4109 about 1500 feet above Copper Creek Bridge
from here 500 feet in a west direction to a post marked No. 2
from here 1300 feet in a north direction to a post marked No. 3
from here 600 feet in a west direction to a post marked No. 4
and from here 1300 feet in a north direction to the point of beginning

Notice of location must be recorded within thirty days from the date of discovery at the office of the auditor of the county in which such discovery was made. Twenty Acres may be included in one placer claim and if located on surveyed land it must be according to legal subdivisions.

Care must be taken to fully describe the claim with reference to natural objects and permanent monuments or survey description, so that the boundaries can be readily traced. The blank spaces in this form must be carefully and properly filled out.

The discoverer must perform labor upon such location in developing the same to an amount which shall be equivalent in the aggregate to at least \$10.00 worth of such labor for each twenty acres, or fractional part thereof, contained in such location or claim, within sixty days from the date of discovery, and upon performance of such labor, file with the auditor of county an affidavit showing such performance and generally the nature and kind of work so done. Provided however, that certain federal regulations may apply, in addition or in place of the above.

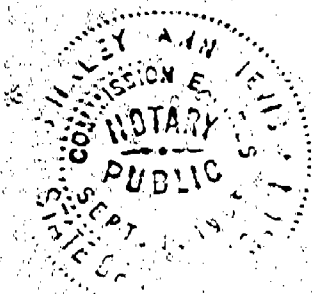
