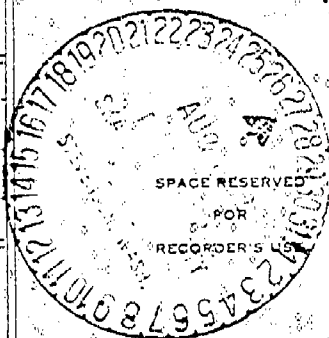

Because BLM recordation regulations change periodically, you should obtain recordation regulations from your local BLM office to determine effective requirements for mining claims.
