New Bearing Trees:

6" D-Fir N10W, 7.0 ft. scribed 1/32" upper blaze and a lower blaze scribed BT and with a 3/4" Brass disk stamped PLS 16337.

5" D-Fir S2E, 11.0 ft. scribed 1/32" upper blaze and a lower blaze scribed BT and with a 3/4" Brass disk stamped PLS 16337.

Set guard post Northwest with sign 54-4 only.

Nailed 54-4 and BT signs to BT's and painted band and blazes red.
