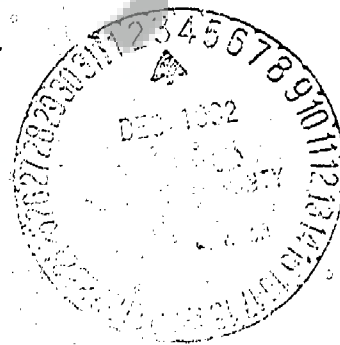
## 1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found:

Today there is no evidence of the original bearing trees. In 1952, Bonneville Power Administration found a stake in a North-South and East fence corner. According to Louis Larson who was born and raised near here, and who still lives on part of the old Larson homestead, this has always been the corner. He said there was an old homesteader's cabin just a short distance from this corner. This area did not burn until 1915, so with the early settlement in this area, in all likelihood, this is a perpetuation of the original corner. Also, there are a couple old surveys around 1910 that tie to this corner. One is Road Book 4, Page 113, Skamania County. I also searched for this corner in 1968.
