1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found:

In 1975, I found the remains of a 40-inch diameter line tree. Being this tree was so close to the corner, I used it the same as a bearing tree and chained South 106 feet and set a 3/4-inch Iron Pipe. I feel this method puts the corner closer to its original position than by proportioning. There is not likely to be a chaining error over this level of ground and for such a short distance.



2. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record.

Found a 3/4-inch Iron Pipe and replaced it with a 2-inch diameter aluminum pipe and cap. References are as follows:

8-inch diameter Douglas Fir North 86° East, 13.0 feet, scribed
"S 25, T4N R7 1/2 E BT" with railroad spike at the base.

16-inch diameter Douglas Fir South 16° West, 4.27 feet, scribed
"S 36, T4N R7 1/2 E BT" with railroad spike at the base.
