CLAIM OF TIMBER LIEN

PAT WEDDICK CLAIMANT, VS. PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that PAT WEDRICK, of Klickitat County, State of Washington, claims alien upon loads of logs, being about 27 truck loads of logs delivered to PACKWOOD LUMBER COMPANY of Packwood, Washington, and 13 truckloads of logs delivered to COWLIZ STUMP MILL in Randle, Washington, in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, and manufactured in Lewis County all in the State of Washington, are marked thus 2, and are now lying in PACKWOOD LUMBER COMPANY in

Packwood, Washington, and COWLITZ STUD MILL in Randle, Washington, for
labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling and delivering
said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner, is Pacific
Lumber and Shipping; that Pacific Lumber and Shipping employed Paramount
Helicopters and said Paramount Helicopters employed said Pat Wedrick to
perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms
and conditions, to-wit:

The said Paramount Helicopters agreed to pay the said Pat Wedrick
for such labor and assistance \$136.00 per load to Packwood, Washington,
and \$109.17 per load to Randle, Washington; that said contract has been
faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of Pat Wedrick,
who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling and delivering said
logs for the period of 17 days; that said labor and assistance were so
performed and rendered upon said logs between the 29th day of November,
1982, and the 15th day of December, 1982; and the rendition of said
service was closed on the 15th day of December, 1982, and thirty days
have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand
for said service is \$4,929.21; that no part thereof has been paid; except

1 \$0.06, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after
2 deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$4,929.21, in which
3 amount the claims will rest upon said logs. The said Pat Wedrick also
4 claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said Pacific Lumber and
5 Shipping of said county, to secure payment for the work and labor
6 performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles, or other
7 timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
