CLAIM OF TIMBER LIEN

DON MOSER CLAIMANT, VS. PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that DON MOSER, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon loads of logs, being about 42 truck loads of logs delivered to PACKWOOD LUMBER COMPANY of Packwood, Washington, and 15 truckloads of logs delivered to COWLITZ STUD MILL in Randle, Washington, in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County and manufactured in Lewis County all in the State of Washington, are marked thus Lo, and are now lying in PACKWOOD LUMBER COMPANY in Packwood, Washington and COWLITZ STUD MILL in Randle, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling and delivering said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner, is Pacific Lumber and Shipping; that Pacific Lumber and Shipping employed Paramount Helicopters and said Paramount Helicopters employed said Don Moser to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Paramount Helicopters agreed to pay the said Don Moser for such labor and assistance \$130.00 per load to Packwood, Washington, and \$109.00 per load to Randle, Washington; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of Don Moser who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling and delivering said logs for the period of 19 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 29th day of November, 1982, and the 19th day of December, 1982; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 15th day of December, 1982, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$7,204.00; that no part thereof has been paid except

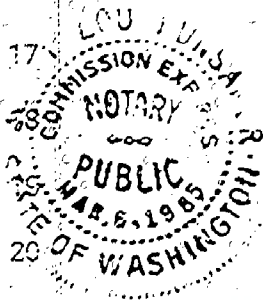
