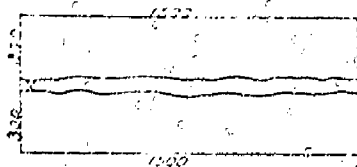


NOTICE OF MINING LOCATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned who is/are (ha S declared His intention to become) citizen of the United States, ha ✓ discovered and ha S located and claimed and do es hereby locate linear feet in length, and feet in width on the Little-Triples #1 Claim Lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County (or Recording Precinct) and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel), from thence 300 feet in a S. westerly direction to an end post marked No. 2, thence 200 feet in a S. easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 3, thence 1500 feet in a N. Easterly direction to a corner post marked No. 4, thence 200 feet in a N. westerly direction to a corner post marked No. 5, thence 300 feet in a N. westerly direction to a corner post marked No. 6, thence 1500 feet in a S. westerly direction to said end post No. 2; hereby locating and intending to claim 300 feet in a S. Easterly direction from discovery to the S. West end line, and 1200 feet in the opposite direction from discovery to the North East end line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is further described by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments as follows:

This claim is further described as being 40 feet from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity, to wit: Sec 17 T4N R5 E W 1/4

This discovery consists of multiple lodes and disseminated copper with associated minerals

Permanent monument B.M. 1159

The general course or strike of the lode or ledge as nearly as may be determined is N. Easterly with reference to permanent monument described above.

This notice is placed at Discovery on post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner, and the name of this lode, and date of location, are placed on all posts.
