Thence South 89° 04' 29" East, parallel to the North line of said Southwest quarter to the Westerly right of way line of Duncan Creek Road;

Thence Northerly along the West right of way line of Duncan Creek Road to the North line of said Southwest quarter;


Thence North 89° 04' 29" West along the North line of said Southwest quarter to the point of beginning.
