Stone mound and hub North 1 foot from corner position as determined from
found B.T. faces (not accepted).

On 11-3-82, the D.N.R. set a standard D.N.R. concrete monument with stamped brass cap by intersecting G.L.O. distances from B.T. stumps.

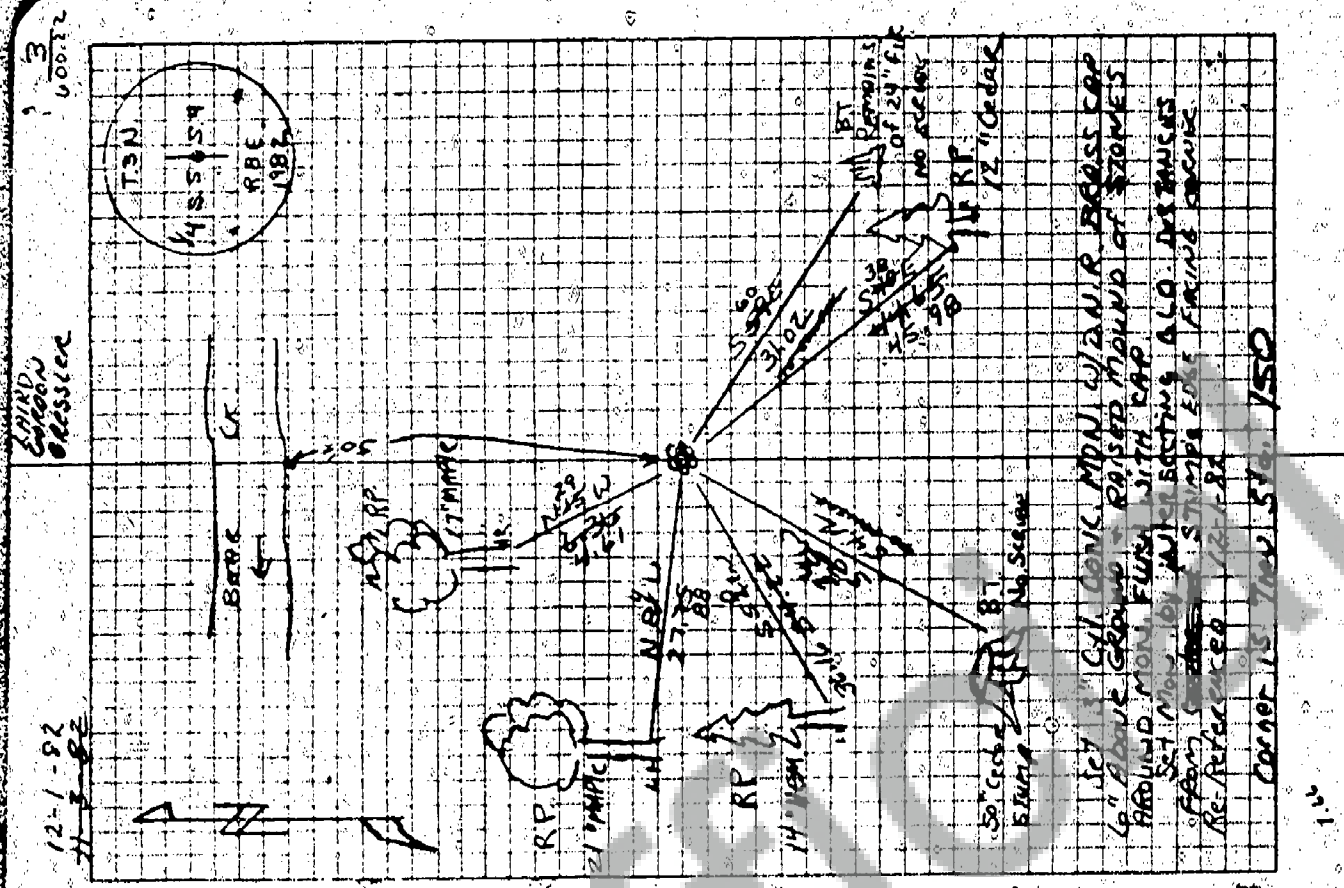

FOUND: BT. Pattern + mound of Rock w/ painted nub. I measured from Faces + PT fell from 1' south of MOB, I dug TO FIND TRACE OF POST + FOUND NOB. METS. FROM CENTERS + FELL 2' SOUTH OF MOUND (MOB) AND GLD. BEARINGS FELL BETTER. SET MOVEMENT FROM CENTER OF BT'S. ROCKS OF MOUND WERE NOT MOSSY + ARE SUBJECT TO FLOWING IN high water. OLD RUSTED IRON TAG + FORST SERVICE TAG SAYS "APPROX 1/4 54 1/4" ON 18' RIDE 6' N.W. of COR.

No other surveys of record.

12-1-82 After being to other corners around the section, I determined that the GLD surveys measured from the faces of the BTs. I moved this monument to conform to that standard.
