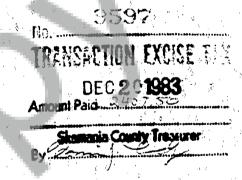

All payments to be made hereunder shall be made at

or at such other place as the seller may direct in writings

As referred to in this contract, "date of closing, shall be date of recording.

(1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between grantor and grantee hereafter become a lien on said realt estate; and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgage, contract or other encumbrance or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to any taxes or assessments now a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

(2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is sully paid to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed on said real estate insured to the actual cash valle, thereof against loss or damage by both fire and windstorm in a company acceptable to the scher, and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof, to the seller. the selier.

(3) The purchaser agrees that hull inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant on agreement for alterations, improvements, or repairs unless the covenant or agreement relied on is contained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.

(4) The purchaser assumes all hazards of damage to destruction of any improvements now on said real estate or hereafter placed thereon, and of the taking of said real estate or army part thereof for public use; and agrees that no such damage, destruction or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration of the case any part of said teal estate is taken for public use, the portion of the condemnation award remaining after payment of reasonable expenses of procuring the same shall be paid to the seller and applied as payment on the purchase price herein unless the seller elects to allow the purchase price herein unless the seller elects to allow the purchase of damage or destruction from a perile insured against the proceeds of such too of any improvements damaged by such taking. (5) The selfer has delivered, or agrees to deliver within 15 days of the date of closing, a purchaser's policy of title insurance in standard form, or a commitment therefore issued by Commonwealth Eand Title Insurance Company insuring the purchaser to the full amount of said purchase price against loss or damage by reason of defect in seller's title to said real estate as of the date of closing and containing no exceptions other than the following:

a. Printed general exceptions appearing in said policy form;

b. Liens or encumbrances which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and

Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title.

(6) If seller setitle to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, or any mortgage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract. (7) The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter deliver to purchaser a statutory warranty is a taken for public use, free of encumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following: Subject to restrictions, reservations, covenants, agreements, easements assessments and taxes of record, if any. (8) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvements on said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use or permit the use of, the real estate for any illegal purpose. The purchaser comenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the dite purchasers entitled to possession. (0) In case the purchaser fails to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein required, the seller may make such payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so paid by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon. from date of payment until repaid shall be repayable by purchaser on seller's demand, all without prejudice to any other right the seller might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fail to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the seller may elect to declare all the purchaser hereunder terminated and upon his doing so, all payments made by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate and no waiver by the seller of any default on the part of the purchaser shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default.

Service upon purchaser of all demands, notices or other papers with respect to forieiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by United States Mail, postage pre-paid, return, receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address last known to the seller.

(11) Upon, seller's election to bring suit to enforce any covenant of this contract, including suit to collect any payment required hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, which sums shall be included in any indement or degree entered in such suit. sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit, If the seller shall bring suit to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights hereunder, and judgment is so entered, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and also the reasonable cost of searching records to determine the condition of title at the date such suit is commenced, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit. EXHIBIT "A"

1. Down payment of \$20,000.00 is to be paid as follows:

\$6,000.00 cash at closing \$14,000.00 per terms of 30 day promissory note

- Punchaser shall have the option to make annual payments of interest only for the first ื two years of this contract. If interest only payments are made they would be as follows: First year interest payment of \$20,500.00 due December 16, 1984 Second year interest payment of \$20,500.00 due December 16, 1985.
- Beginning with the third annual installment and continuing through the sixth annual installment, purchaser shall pay a minimum principal payment of \$20,000.00 plus all accrued, unpaid interest as computed on the diminishing principal balance.
- 4. Any remaining unpaid principal plus all accrued, unpaid interest is due and payable on on before December 16, 1990 (seven years from the date of closing):
- The purchaser further agrees to pay interest on the diminishing balance of said purchase price at the rate of 10% per annum from the 16 day of December;
- The purchaser further agrees to apply 75 per cent of net profit from timber sales from subject property to the contract payments.
- All annual payments under this agreement are to be paid within 30 days from due date.
- Purchaser agrees to accept responsibility for obtaining right of way access to subject property. Purchaser is aware that said access is now in dispute.
- Purchaser is aware that there is an unrecorded agreement with the Army Corp of Engineers for placement and maintenance of an instrument used to monitor Bonneville Dam.
