The discoverer must perform labor upon such claim or location, in the aggregate to at least \$10.00 worth of such labor for each twenty acres, or fractional part thereof, contained in such location or claim, within sixty days from the date of discovery, and upon performance of such labor, file with the auditor of the county an affidavit showing such performance and generally the nature and kind of work so done.
