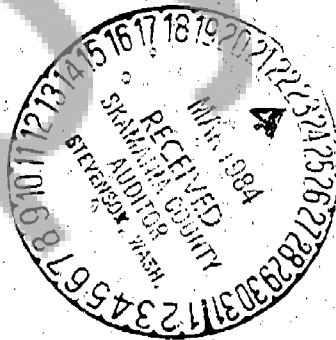
18" D-Fir N65W-38.5 ft. scribed 1/8S6BT and with a 3/4" Brass disk stamped PLS 16337.

Painted red band on all BT's - painted face of all BT's and nailed 54-4 and BT signs.

Set guard post 14 ft. West of monument on R/W line of road with decal survey marker only.

Nailed 54-4 and 54-3 to all BT's.
