

EASEMEN'T

PACIFIC ROWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a Maine corporation, Pacific, hereby grants to PUBLISHERS-FOREST PRODUCTS COMPANY OF WASHINGTON, Grantee, its successors and assigns, a nonexclusive easement and right of way sixty (60) feet in width, to use, maintain and reconstruct that certain road known as Marble Mountain Road, lying northerly of Lewis River Road N90, for forestry and logging purposes, over and across racific's real property located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., Skamania County, Washington, as more particularly shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the following conditions, to wit:

- 1. Grantee's use of said road hereunder shall be exercised in common with Pacific, its successors and assigns, and the licensees and invitees thereof and as hereinafter provided.
- 2. The easement hereby granted is subject to all easements and encumbrances of record.
- 3. Grantee shall fully comply with all Forest Protection Laws and Regulations thereunder of the United States, the State of Washington, or other governmental bodies having jurisdiction.
- 4. Grantee shall pay to Pacific the current market value mill scale within thirty (30) days of felling of any merchantable timber on said right of way cut or damaged by Grantee.
- 5. Grantee assumes all risk in connection with its use of the premises and shall indemnify and hold Pacific, its directors, officers and employees harmless against and from any and all claims, suits, costs, demands, damages, loss, liability or expense, including attorney's fees for injury to or death of persons or damage to property, including property of Pacific, caused by or in any way arising out of Grantee's use of or occupancy of said premises.
- 6. Pacific shall have no obligation to maintain said road, or to require others to whom it may grant use rights to perform such maintenance; but in the event Pacific or others to whom Pacific may grant use rights shall use said road for heavy hauling purposes, Pacific or such others, in any year

in which Grantee has expended funds to maintain said road, may respectively be required by Grantee to share in such maintenance expense in the proportion that Pacific's own or the use by such others for such heavy hauling purposes bears to all such use for heavy hauling purposes.

- 7. Pacific reserves the right at any time to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain electric transmission and distribution lines and communication lines upon, over, across and under the road and premises above described and the right to relocate or reconstruct said road, or portions thereof, as may be required in connection with the construction, reconstruction, operation or maintenance of its hydroelectric project and such transmission, distribution and communication lines.
- 8. The rights and obligations hereunder shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective successors and assigns of the parties hereto.


