

DEED OF TRUST

This Deed of Trust is made this 14th day of June, 1984, between **ALLEN D. SMITH and BARBARA E. SMITH**, husband and wife, Grantors, whose address is North Bonneville, Washington 98610; **Skamania County Title, Inc.**, a Washington corporation, as Trustee, whose address is Stevenson, Washington and **NELL L. HILL**, a single woman, and **R. LEE MacDONALD**, a single woman, as tenants in common, as Beneficiaries, whose address is MP 45.93 R State Road 14, Stevenson, Washington 98648.

Grantors hereby bargain, sell and convey to Trustee in trust, with power of sale, the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington:

That portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 6 E.W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at a point 68.5 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 26, said point being on the northerly right of way line of primary State Road No. 8 as presently constructed and located; thence North along the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the said Section 26 a distance of 424.5 feet to the initial point of the tract hereby described; thence North $81^{\circ} 13'$ West 1,010 feet, more or less, to a point South $25^{\circ} 14'$ West from the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the said Section 26; thence North $25^{\circ} 14'$ East to intersection with the North line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the said Section 26; thence East 651.07 feet to the Northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 26; thence South to the initial point; Except tracts heretofore conveyed from Sam Samson and Flora Samson, husband and wife, and their predecessors in interest; and except the following described tract: Beginning at the Southwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to Jerry L. Randall, et ux, by deed dated October 30, 1964, and recorded at page 325 of Book 53 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County, Washington; thence northwesterly along the westerly line of said tract and its extension northerly to the North line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the said Section 26; thence East along said North line to the Northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the said Section 26; thence South along the East line of said subdivision to the northerly line of the county road known and designated as Little Street to the point of beginning;

Except That tract conveyed to Donald R. Stierns, a single man, and Lavaune R. Gromko, a single woman, recorded in Book 67 of Deeds at page 413, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

Except those tracts conveyed to Byron L. Duke and Janet L. Duke, husband and wife, and Curtis W. Faulconer, a single man, as recorded in Book 69 of Deeds at Page 245, and in Book

69 of Deeds at page 244, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

Except that tract conveyed to Tom E. Fortenbury in Book 81 of Deeds at page 93, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

Except that portion conveyed to Ernest C. Roberts, et ux in Book 69 of Deeds at page 162, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

Except that tract conveyed to LeRoy Leslie Watson in Book 32 of Deeds at page 386.

And except that tract conveyed to Evelyn L. McKnight in Book 51 of Deeds at page 53, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

This Deed is for the purpose of securing performance of each agreement of Grantors herein contained and payment of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) with interest, in accordance with the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith payable to Beneficiaries or order and made by Grantors, and all renewals, modifications and extensions thereof.

To protect the security of this Deed of Trust, Grantors covenant and agree:

1. To keep the property in good condition and repair; to permit no waste thereof; to complete any building, structure or improvement being built or about to be built thereon; to restore promptly any building, structure or improvement thereon which may be damaged or destroyed; and to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting the property.
2. To pay before delinquent all lawful taxes and assessments upon the property and upon this Deed of Trust or upon the money or debt secured hereby; to keep the property free and clear of all other encumbrances impairing the security of this Deed of Trust.
3. To keep all buildings now or hereafter erected on the property described herein continuously insured against loss by fire or other hazards in an amount not less than the total debt secured by this Deed of Trust. All policies shall be held by the Beneficiaries and be in such companies as the Beneficiaries may approve and shall have loss payable first to the Beneficiaries as their interest may appear and then to the Grantors. The amount collected under any insurance policy may be applied upon any indebtedness hereby secured in such order as the Beneficiaries shall determine. Such application by the Beneficiaries shall not cause discontinuance of any proceedings to foreclose this Deed of Trust. In the event of foreclosure all rights of the Grantors in insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser at the foreclosure sale.
4. To defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof or the rights or powers of Beneficiaries or Trustee, and to pay all costs and expenses, including cost of title search and attorney's fees in a reasonable amount, in any such action or proceeding, and in any suit brought by Beneficiaries to foreclose this Deed of Trust.
5. To pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust, including the expenses of the Trustee incurred in enforcing this obligation, and Trustee's and attorney's fees actually incurred, as provided by statute.

6. Should Grantors fail to pay any taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, liens or other charges payable by Grantors, Beneficiaries may pay the same, and the amount so paid, with interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby, shall be added to and become a part of the debt secured by this Deed of Trust.

7. That the real property hereby conveyed is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes.

It is Further Agreed That:

1. In the event any portion of the property is taken or damaged in an eminent domain proceeding, the entire amount of the award shall be paid to Beneficiaries to be applied to the obligation secured hereby.

2. By accepting payment of any sum secured hereby after its due date, Beneficiaries do not waive their right to require prompt payments when due of all other sums so secured or to declare default for failure to so pay.

3. The Trustee shall reconvey all or any part of the property covered by this Deed of Trust to the person entitled thereto on written request of the Grantors and the Beneficiaries, or upon satisfaction of the obligation secured and written request for reconveyance made by the Beneficiaries or the person entitled thereto.

4. Upon default by Grantors in the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in the performance of any agreement contained herein, all sums secured hereby shall immediately become due and payable at the option of the Beneficiaries. In such event and upon written request of Beneficiaries, Trustee shall sell the trust property, in accordance with the Deed of Trust Act of the State of Washington, at public auction to the highest bidder. Any person except Trustee may bid at Trustee's sale. Trustee shall apply the proceeds of the sale as follows: 1) to the expense of sale, including a reasonable Trustee's fee and attorney's fee; 2) to the obligation secured by this Deed of Trust; 3) the surplus, if any, shall be distributed to the persons entitled thereto.

5. Trustee shall deliver to the purchaser at the sale its deed, without warranty, which shall convey to the purchaser the interest in the property which Grantors had or had the power to convey at the time of their execution of this Deed of Trust, and such as he may have acquired thereafter. Trustee's deed shall recite the facts showing that the sale was conducted in compliance with all the requirements of law and of this Deed of Trust, which recital shall be prima facie evidence of such compliance and conclusive evidence thereof in favor of bona fide purchasers and encumbrances for value.

6. The power of sale conferred by this Deed of Trust and by the Deed of Trust Act of the State of Washington is not an exclusive remedy and when not exercised, Beneficiaries may foreclose this Deed of Trust as a mortgage.

7. In the event of the death, incapacity or disability or resignation of Trustee, Beneficiaries may appoint in writing a successor trustee, and upon the recording of such appointment in the mortgage records of the county in which this Deed of Trust is recorded, the successor trustee shall be vested with all powers of the original trustee. The Trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending sale under any other Deed of Trust or of any action or proceeding in which Grantors, Trustee, or Beneficiaries shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is

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brought by the Trustee.

8. This Deed of Trust applies to, inures to the benefit of, and is binding not only on the parties hereto, but on their heirs, devisees, legatees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns. The term Beneficiaries shall mean the holder and owner of the role secured hereby, whether or not named as Beneficiaries herein.
