Jack Bartlett Claimant, vs Crown Zellerbach and Northwest Forest Products

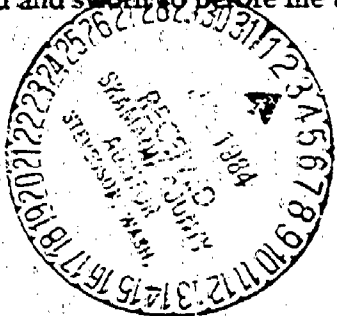
Notice is hereby given that Jack Bartlett of Cowlitz county, State of Washington, claims a lien upon 538,274 pds. of log, being about 180 log in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Shannon county, State of Washington, are marked fall CLS-M 45 thus CM-Nover, and are now lying in NW Forest Products, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in transporting said log; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is NW Forest Products, that NW Forest Products employed said Jack Bartlett to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said NW Forest Products agreed to pay the said Jack Bartlett for such labor and assistance rate; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Jack Bartlett, who performed labor upon and assisted in transporting said log for the period of 5 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said NW Forest Products between the 16th day of June 1984 and the 21st day of June 1984 and the rendition of said service was closed on the 13th day of June 1984, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$2233.12; that no part thereof has been paid except None, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$2233.12, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs & chips. The said Jack Bartlett also claims a lien on all said logs & chips now owned by said Crown Zellerbach and Northwest Forest Products of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or slingles herein described.
