Found 72" fir stump with healed scar North 85 feet

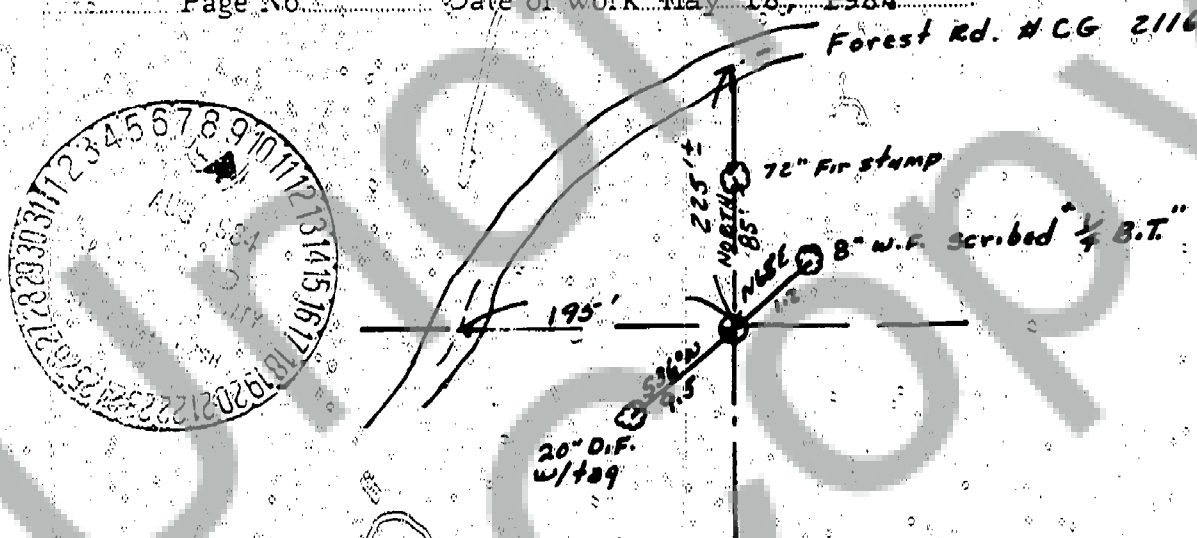
Found 20" Douglas fir with Longview Fibre tag S. 36° W. 9.5 feet
