(1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency, all taxes and assessments that may as between granton and grantee. hereafter become a lienson said realiestate and ill by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgage, contract or Other encumbrance; or has assumed payment of for agreed to purchase subject to any taxes or assessments now a lier on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

- "Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title.
- (6) If seller satisfie to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, or any mortgage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract,

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(7) The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deliver to fulfillment deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof, hereafter taken for public use, free of encumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following. Easement granted to the Northwestern Electric Company, by deed dated December 2, 1929, recorded May 9, 1930, at page 389 of Book "W" of Deeds. Easement and right of way for Turk Road, as delineated on the face of the shortplat. 60 foot private road and utilities easement as delineated on the shortplat. 30 foot easement for access and utilities as delineated on the face of the shortplat. (8). Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said realiestate on date of closing and to retain possession, so long as purchase, is not invide fault; hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvements on said real/estate in good repair and notito permittiwaster and notito use; or permit the use of the real estate for any illegal purpose. The purchaser covenants, to pay all service installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.
