7141 West First Lake District

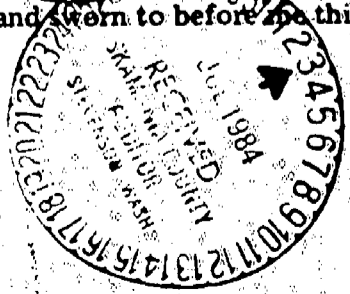
Notice is hereby given that Jack Smith of Cumby county, State of Washington, claims a lien upon 58,284 of logs, being about 180 logs in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania county, State of Washington, are marked thus CS-11-115 and are now lying in William Zellback and, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in transporting said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is William Zellback; that Jack Smith employed said Jack Smith to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said William Zellback agreed to pay the said Jack Smith for such labor and assistance state; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Jack Smith, who performed labor upon and assisted in transporting said logs for the period of 5 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said 7141 West First Lake District between the 6th day of June 1984 and the 13th day of June 1984 and the rendition of said service was closed on the 13th day of June 1984, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$233.13; that no part thereof has been paid except none, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$233.13, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs chips. The said Jack Smith also claims a lien on all said logs chips now owned by said William Zellback of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
