
(2) That in return for said payment LEE DUNN agrees to quitclaim any interest which he has in the subject property; to-wit:

- (5) SKAMANIA COUNTY agrees to allow LEE DUNN access on to FARNSWORTH ROAD at a point of his choosing and further agrees to allow LEE DUNN to fild the towe of FARNSWORTH ROAD so as to enable him to seed the same; that SKAMANIA COUNTY agrees not to spray the seeded area in the future.
