This grant is made subject to the interests, rights, and privileges 2. of both the United States and Burlington Northern Railroad Company as set forth in that certain easement dated January 13, 1982, and recorded in Book 80, page 972, Skamania County, Washington, records, which interests, rights, and privileges together with the right to construct, reconstruct, and maintain the road are herein reserved, except the United States does not reserve in this patent the title to any timber within the easement, but only the right to cut and deck for use of the landowner such timber as may be necessary to accommodate the construction and maintenance of the roads on the reserved rights-of-way.
