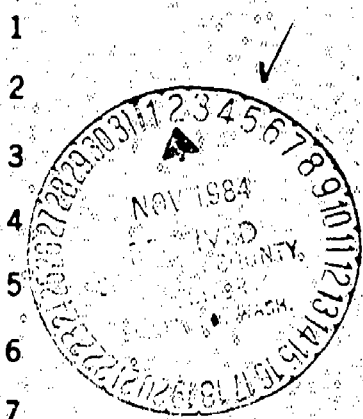

15 THIS MATTER having come regularly on for hearing as an
 16 uncontested action for dissolution, the Petitioner appearing in
 17 person and by her attorneys, Boettcher, LaLonde, Kleweno, Dunn,
 18 Ladley, Witteman & Schreiber, GILBERT H. KLEWENO of Counsel, the
 19 Respondent not having denied that the marriage of the parties
 20 herein is irretrievably broken, and more than ninety (90) days
 21 having elapsed since the service of process and the filing of
 22 the Petition in this action, and the Findings of Fact and
 23 Conclusions of Law having heretofore been duly entered, and the
 24 Court being fully advised in the premises, it is now, therefore,
 25 ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

- 26 1. That a Decree of Dissolution be, and hereby is, granted,
 27 dissolving the marriage of the partners.
 28 2. That Petitioner be, and hereby is, awarded as her sole
 29 and separate property:
 30 a. Her personal effects and belongings.
 31 b. Those items of miscellaneous household goods
 32 and furnishings presently in her possession.

26 Petitioner free and harmless therefrom, EXCEPT as otherwise

27 specifically set forth herein, and EXCEPT for that outstanding

28 indebtedness owing to the First Independent Bank and that out-

29 standing indebtedness owing to VISA, which Petitioner shall assume

30 and pay, holding Respondent free and harmless therefrom.

31 That each of the parties hereto be, and hereby are, required

32 and directed to assume and be responsible for any and all indebted-

ness incurred by him or her subsequent to the date of separation

herein, holding the other free and harmless therefrom, EXCEPT

as otherwise specifically set forth herein.

5. That Petitioner be, and hereby is, awarded the

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1 restoration of her former name of HOFFMAN.
