

## Notice of Location of Placer Claim

**Washington** STATE of **OREGON** County of **Skamania** **Wind River** Mining District.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of 1.60 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the Curly Rock #15 Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

If claim is on surveyed land:

This claim comprises the N.E. 1/4 of Section 12, Township 4 N., Range 8 E. of the Willamette Meridian.

The location of this claim is distinctly marked on the ground so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced: Starting at the corner of the quarter section, thence in a northwesterly direction 100 feet, more or less, to the beginning point of the description of the placer claim hereby located, to-wit: a substantial post set in the ground, marked Post No. 1; thence 100 feet in a southwesterly direction, to a post marked No. 2; thence 100 feet in a southerly direction, to a post marked No. 3; thence 100 feet in a northwesterly direction, to a post marked No. 4; thence 100 feet in a southerly direction, to a post marked No. 5; thence 100 feet in a northwesterly direction, to a post marked No. 6; thence 100 feet in a southerly direction, to a post marked No. 7; thence 100 feet in a northwesterly direction, to a post marked No. 8; thence 100 feet in a southerly direction, to the post marked No. 1. This claim is situated in the SW 1/4 (quarter section) of Section 12, Township 4 N., Range 8 E. of the Willamette Meridian, either as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed.

The locators intend to hold and work the above described claim as provided by the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon and claim all of the rights and privileges granted by existing laws and customs. In constituting this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa if the context so requires.
